

Access

From Aomori Airport

1. Take a bus from Aomori Airport to Aomori Station (approx. 35 mins). ↓ Transfer

2. From bus stop no. 10 at Aomori Station, take a Towada Kanko Dentetsu bus for Towada City (approx. 1.5 hrs). Get off at Kanchogai Street (Kanchogai-dori).

From Hachinohe Station

• At the East Exit of Hachinohe Station, take any Towada Kanko Dentetsu bus that departs from bus stop no. (5) (approx. 1 hr). Get off at Kanchogai Street (Kanchogai-dori), and walk for about 5 minutes At the West Exit of Hachinohe Station, take a

JR Oirase-go bus, which stops right in front of the Towada Art Center (approx. 40 mins).


